PROJECT: Safe Dance Floor for Only Inclusion School PS372

PS372 is the only elementary school in NYC where all children work side-by-side throughout the day with classmates who have a range of abilities and disabilities. This “Inclusion” philosophy puts a General Education and a Special Education teacher in every class, and our 20+ years of success with this model have shown that all children benefit from this unique educational and social learning environment.

Due to the unsafe linoleum floor, the 800 sq ft dance studio space is currently unusable. Students are forced to use the gym stage to execute dance movements while ongoing gym classes are present. The noise from 2 classes in the same space challenges all students’ attention and inhibits what can be taught for both classes.

PS372 needs a dance studio upgrade (wood floor and ADA compliant ramp) to help all students meet their diverse needs and maximize their potential, both academically and socially. The dance studio space is the only separate dance facility available that not only benefits all of our Pre-K through 5th grade classes, but is also utilized by the neighborhood community for events and functions.
