SYNTH BitBots

Let's Rock! In SYNTH BitBots the students will be the master craftsmen of their own musical instruments using the newest kit offered by littleBits, the Synth Kit. LittleBits are simple electronic modules, each with specific functions, which can be snapped together magnetically to create large and elaborate circuits for prototyping and play. When used in conjunction with materials such as cardboard, legos, paper, reused plastic and more, littleBits bring to life anything a child can imagine! The students will have the experience of starting with nothing but an idea, to learning about the littleBits, conceptualizing and creating an instrument which they can play, and finally adapting their favorite songs to their instruments. Ultimately, the goal for this class is for the students to use their innovative instruments to form a band with a sound unlike any other.
