If a class is filled or cancelled, you will be contacted by the After School Registrar and be reimbursed.

Notification:

Please inform your child's classroom teachers in writing of which Enrichment class(es) they are taking and advise the classroom teachers of ALL schedule changes.

Pick-up:

Pick up is in the gym. Please enter from 1st Street. Please exit the building quickly, After School is in session and we need to ensure every child's safety. Please do not socialize or linger in the gym.

Late Fee Policy:

Pick up is at 4:40pm SHARP. Anyone more than 15 minutes late will be charged \$25.00. Habitual lateness will result in expulsion. Please call the After School phone if you are late or if there is any change with your pick up plan.

Student Conduct:

The Enrichment Program does not have the same staff resources that are available during the school day. Unfortunately, we may not be able to adequately serve children who repeatedly require one-to-one supervision. Repeated unsafe behavior may result in a student's dismissal from the Enrichment Program.
